Artists Group that will homestay with families in the Miasa-Omachi area. There will be a limited number of artists selected to participate in the trip to Japan. The amount of artists allowed on the trip is yet to be decided. Artists will pay their own airfare and any personal expenses while in Japan. Details will be discussed after selection.

The trip is tentatively scheduled for June 27th - July 13th or 14th. There will be two shows. The first is in Matsumoto City Museum of Art, May 24-29 and then in Omachi from June 24-July30.
